What do I need for a LIBRARY CARD?

To obtain your Library card you must:

- Live in Penn or Harris township, OR have a home Library card from a Library system which is reciprocal with MPHPL* (some restrictions may apply).
- 2. Provide required documentation:
 - 1. a valid photo ID with current address OR
 - a valid photo ID and proof of current address** if ID address is not current OR
 - 3. a valid photo ID and a valid resident home Library card for reciprocal applicants.

3. A parent/legal guardian's signature is required for any minor under the age of 18 wishing to register for or renew a Library card.
